

SOUNDPHREAKERS BIOGRAPHY

Soundphreakers project is a group of two producers Nois and Neon, based on 1997 at Slovak Republic. The first CD named „Just Meat“ was released in 1998 and brought a collection of their's production until 1998.

Three years later, on 2001 became the first success. Slovak cell phone operator Globtel (formerly Orange) released their's track „Antrax“ on multimedia CD – Globtel CD In 03. On the same year Soundphreakers based the Internet magazine Audionet.sk (www.audionet.sk) focused on music production and producers and own independent music label Phreak da Sound with the release of their's second album “Noteless Sphere of Infection”. The next release was the first Slovak drum&bass compilation Remark the Silence, with Soundphreaker's track “What's go Out”.

On 2002 Soundphreakers performed several performances in Bratislava and Trnava, some of them as a project Random Logic. They were invited to one of the biggest Czech music festival Summer Of Love and Slovak festival BeeFree 2002. Beginning on this year, they are focused deeply in drum&bass, which is their's present music genre.

Year 2003 was breaking-thru. Next volume of drum&bass compilation Remark the Silence 2 included two tracks Saddam and Startex Mood as well as nine-th and ten-th volume of CD IN by Orange released in 100 000 pieces have had their's tracks Saddam and Centrum 2 feat. Mek Vrabc. The Czech magazine Bassline Elektronik released the track State in 10 000 – pieces released CD included with the magazine. In this year Soundphreakers started their's DJ career playing at Summer of Love 2003 (Pardubice / Czech Republic) where play also EZ Rollers & Lady Roller (Moving Shadow, UK), Hodokvas 2003 (Pezinok/SK) a Roxy Fest 2003 (Košice/SK). Most of played tracks are their own production.

Soundphreakers has been playing at different club all around Slovakia: Spojka, Duna, U-Club, Wave Club, Reset Club. They have started own clubbing events Phreak da Sound in club Duna, Bratislava with more than 19 events until now. Every event shows different Slovak drum'n bass producer playing live and one hour mixed set by Soundphreakers, compiled of Slovak, Czech, Poland and other producers and their's production. Their's set has been played at Slovak radio RockFM, which can be downloaded from their's homepage in section Audio – www.soundphreakers.com.

At 2004 there were first performances in foreign club. Soundphreakers was invited to event Logarithm in F-Club, Vranovice, Czech Republic. Same time they appear on third volume of compilation Remark the Silence with track “Get Down”. At summer they have performed at Slovak festival Prvý Máj, supporting DJ Keaton from Usual Suspects, UK. Short time before they have performed at event Drum&Bass Fashion Semtex Sessions in club Matrix, Prague, Czech Republic.

At 2004 there were several performances: at one of the biggest festival Bažant Pohoda, Trenčín, Slovak Republic played along with Bad Company, at Nočné Vlasy, Piešťany along with Chris SU & SKC from Hungary and Klute from UK. At the end of the season they won the second place at the competition TOP4DJs and played at the top time at the festival BeeFree 2004 and the open-air festival Hodokvas, Pezinok, Slovak Republic with Czech DJs Katcha and IM Cyber and Shapeshifter from Nederland.

At the September 2004 they have been invited to the event named “The Last Meeting of BrokenBeatz” at Krakow, Poland with polish DJ and producer DeeJay Delta. Then they have been invited to Slovak club Reset at Partizánske, where they play with Slovak producer LPLUS their's own production. At the October 2004 they have prepared next mixed promo set with their's own production as well as tracks by Slovak producer B-Complex, Czech Ride, polish DeeJay Delta with Surya and American Fusebox. This promo set has been played at October 27-th at Slovak Radio FM, at the session named Nočný život.
